- Providing suitable and alternate duties for injured workers within their capacity where appropriate;
- Consulting with workers and where applicable, any industrial union of employees representing those workers in developing rehabilitation programs; and
- Ensuring an injured worker will not be disadvantaged or prejudiced while undertaking rehabilitation.
